Question

1. GMI Student Loan Fund

The loan is extended to students showing a legitimate financial need and cannot exceed the lower of \$650 per semester or the total costs of tuition, books and supplies, and student fees. (For sample application forms, see Exhibit A.) The loan may be either long term or short term in duration. The loan is distributed only on a semester basis and is intended to serve as a supplement to financial assistance from the applicant's family. Repayment of a long-term loan extends after graduation over a period of years equal to the number of class years for which amounts were borrowed. Repayment of a short-term loan must occur by the end of the semester following the semester in which the loan was granted.

GMI Tuition and Fees Scholarship

The scholarship covers full tuition and fees to qualifying students who are determined by use of the attached criteria (see Exhibit B). Outstanding students are recommended by high school counselors and the entering freshmen class is screened for possible candidates. The scholarship is awarded for a period of one year, but may be renewed if certain minimum standards are met by the recipient. No award must be repaid by the recipient.

2. GMI Student Loan Fund

There are no restrictions on the class of individuals who are eligible recipients as long as financial need is shown by the individual. All GMI students are eligible for loans.

GMI Tuition and Fees Scholarship

There are no restrictions on the class of individuals who are eligible recipients.

3. GMI Student Loan Fund

In the 1977-1978 school year, 207 long-term loans and 36 short-term loans were granted. No major change in the number of loans is anticipated for future years.

GMI Tuition and Fees Scholarship

Ten scholarships are awarded each year to entering freshmen, which may be renewed annually, provided certain minimum standards are met.
