MSMO Delivery

Kettering University delivers the MSMO program through distance learning methods. Students may complete the entire MSMO program without ever coming to campus. You can select to take courses through CD-Rom, DVD, videotape, or internet video streaming. Course materials are shipped directly to you on a weekly basis, and all homework and assignments are sent electronically. Dual Degree Program

As a prospective student for the University of Michigan–Flint MBA with Lean Manufacturing concentration and Kettering University MSMO Dual Degree Program, you have the option of starting either program first. The requirement for taking the GMAT test for the UM-Flint MBA program may be waived if you successfully complete the Kettering MSMO program first. Prospective students will be required to meet the policies, deadlines, regulations, and requirements of the respective university listed below. We look forward to having you as a student in the Dual Degree program!

Admissions Requirements*

To be considered for the MSMO program, prospective students must submit:

- Completed Kettering University MSMO Graduate Program Application form
- Two letters of recommendation
- Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended
- Proof of MBA degree from University of Michigan-Flint, if completed first

Application Deadlines*

Prospective students may apply and start the MSMO program in any of the 4 terms offered at Kettering University. Admission deadlines below are approximate and you should consult with Kettering University for specific dates:

- Fall Term– Early September
- Winter Term– Mid December
- Spring Term– Early March
- Summer Term– Mid June

Program Cost*

Tuition for the 2006-2007 academic year at Kettering University is \$629 per credit hour. This includes all fees and expenses. Additionally, students are provided FREE textbooks and software.

Miscellaneous Information:

The length of time it takes to complete the MSMO program is dependent upon the number of courses taken per quarter term. You may select as many or as few courses to take each term; although most students take either 1 or 2 courses per term. Kettering operates on 4 quarter terms per year. Selecting 2 courses per term will allow you to complete the MSMO in 15 months.

Admissions Requirements*

To be considered for the MBA with a Lean Manufacturing concentration program, prospective students must submit:

- Completed application for graduate admission
- \$55 application fee
- Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended
- Two letters of recommendation
- Statement of purpose (One-page typed response to the following question: “What are your career objectives and how will an MBA contribute to accomplishing these objectives?”)
- Resume, including work experience and extra curricular activities
- Official GMAT results (this requirement may be waived if you successfully complete the Kettering MSMO program first)
- Proof of MSMO degree from Kettering University, if completed first

Miscellaneous Information

The length of time it takes to complete the MBA program is dependent upon the number of courses taken per semester. Students in the *NetPlus!* program typically take 2 courses in the Fall, Winter, Spring, and Summer terms; thus, completing the MBA program in 18 months. Students in the Traditional MBA program typically take 2 courses in the Fall and Winter terms and 1 course in the Spring or Summer term; thus completing the MBA program in 24 months.
