The Office of International Programs would like to announce the winners of the Fall 2008 Study-Abroad Photo Contest. Students participated by submitting photos taken during the fall 2008 study-abroad term. 16 different photos were entered into the competition, representing sights from countries all over Europe.

The photograph "A Shepherd's Dream" by **Wes Keller** (A Section, Mechanical Engineering, Kankakee, IL) won first place. "A Shepherd's Dream" depicts the Cliffs of Moher, which look over the Atlantic Ocean on the west coast of Ireland.
