LITE is a two-week residential program created by Kettering University to introduce 11th grade girls to engineering specialties. Participants will learn how to design products that have a profound impact on people's lives: air bags, crash test dummies, artificial limbs and organs, and car seats. A degree in engineering prepares students for advanced study and careers in business, medicine, law, and education.

Eligibility Requirements

- Female students who will have completed 11th grade by July 1, 2010.
- Female students who have displayed a strong interest in science and math.
- A 3.0 grade-point average.

There is no cost to apply. If accepted, you will be asked to pay a \$500 program fee. (Financial aid is available; contact the Associate Director for information.)
