### King of Sweden to visit Flint:

The king of Sweden, King Carl XVI Gustaf, is expected to come to Kettering University on Friday, Sept. 26, as part of a two-day trip to Michigan. Kettering Provost Michael Harris told The Flint Journal that plans are under way for a ceremony featuring Gov. Jennifer Granholm and others. Granholm spokeswoman Megan Brown said the governor extended an invitation to Gustaf during her visit to Sweden last year and "is honored that he has accepted." Media announcing the event include:

**Poverty-weary residents see little to no upturn in Flint's fortunes from a U.S. Sugar buyout:** Thirty-five years after his death, automotive pioneer and philanthropist C.S. Mott is about to deliver another gift to his hometown of Flint, this one from the taxpayers of South Florida. If a Mott venture, U.S. Sugar Corp. in Clewiston, is acquired by Florida for \$1.75-billion, a handful of Flint charities holding nearly half of U.S. Sugar's stock will reap a windfall. Clewiston's loss will become Flint's gain — to the tune of more than \$300-million. See:
