

Kettering University Intramural Sports Sportsmanship Rating

Beginning immediately Intramural staff will assign a sportsmanship rating to each team at the conclusion of each contest. This rating will be used as a tool to enforce national standards and the University Code of Conduct with regard to player and spectator sportsmanship towards officials and opponents. This rating will stress eliminating vulgar/obscene language, dissent towards referee decisions and any taunting of opponents. The rating is described below:

4-excellent sportsmanship, no cursing from players or fans, no visible dissent to referee decisions, no ejections.

3-acceptable sportsmanship, no foul language towards officials or opponents but minor peripheral foul language observed, minor dissent towards officials' decisions observed.

2-unacceptable sportsmanship, ejected player or fan, foul language

1-complete lack of sportsmanship, more than 1 ejected player or fan, verbal abuse to staff and or opponent.

Teams must maintain a 2.5 average to advance to the playoffs. Any rating given of a 1 or 2 will result in the team captain meeting with the Director of Intramural Sports. Recreation Services may make necessary administrative decisions to adjust criteria for management of the sport.
