

Kettering University's Online Undergraduate Business Courses

Specific online courses offered by Kettering have a reduced tuition rate and qualification rules apply for enrollment into these courses. This memorandum defines those courses and the rules so everyone understands which courses qualify for this reduced rate.

Reduced Rate Online Business Courses (02W)

- ◆ The reduced rate is *only* for the following online courses offered through the Department of Business: ACCT-212, FINC-311, MRKT-370, and MGMT-350. They will be listed with a section of "02W."
- ◆ Enrollment requires prior approval from the Department of Business.
- ◆ Students must be pursuing a Business Minor and have it noted on their Banner record.
- ◆ Students must be on a coop or thesis term.
- ◆ Some courses include limited enrollment to only Directed Study and/or last-term seniors.

Non-reduced Rate Online Business Courses (03W)

- ◆ If a 03W section exists for these business courses, then students may take these courses (and enroll in the 03W section) during their academic term.
- ◆ 03W sections are not subject to the 02W eligibility rules and *do not qualify* for reduced tuition.

Additional Information

- ◆ Business Majors *are not eligible* for enrollment in any online business courses.
- ◆ Non-business courses taught online, such as MATH-102 and MATH-408 *do not qualify* for the reduced tuition rate.
