- May not be an IFC officer

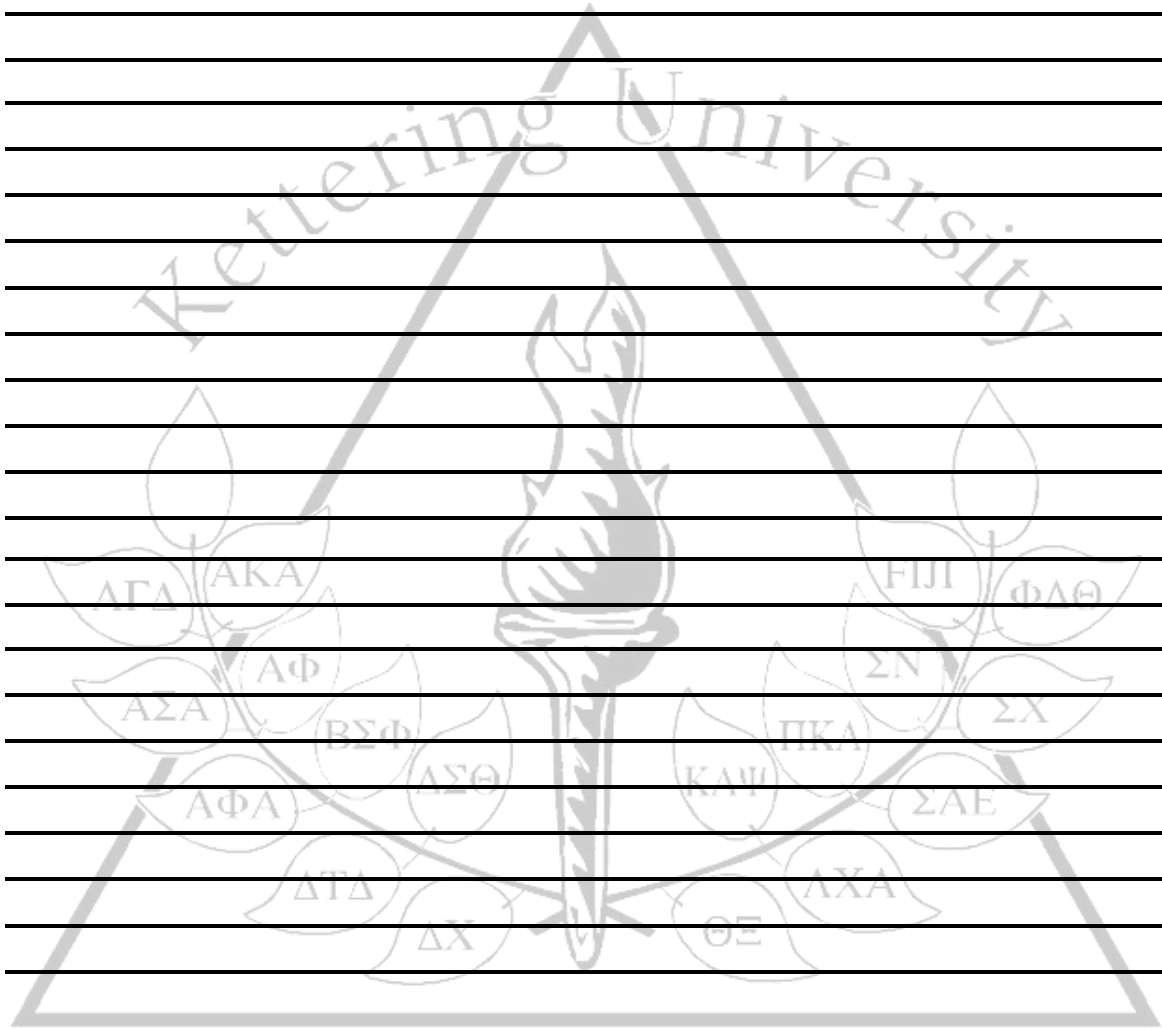
