

# Kettering Recognizes Excellence Scholarship

*Kettering University encourages incoming undergraduate freshmen and transfer students to apply for the Kettering Recognizes Excellence Scholarship. Selected applicants will be awarded up to \$6000 annually in renewable scholarship aid. This scholarship is intended to give students an opportunity to talk about their achievements outside of the classroom – their extraordinary and exemplary talents, their ability to overcome obstacles, and their personal initiative and tenacity.*

## There are many possibilities. Here are just a few examples of what students will write about:

- Exemplary service and dedication as an Eagle Scout or Gold Award winner.
- Commendable work demonstrated at a competitive Science Fair or Engineering Competition.
- Demonstrated leadership and proficiency in an extracurricular endeavor such as Model United Nations, Boys' or Girls' State, or Future Business Leaders of America.
- Excellence demonstrated at Skills U.S.A., Technology Student Association (TSA), MITES, TEAMS, or other professional skill-oriented competitions.
- Exemplary community service-oriented work through National Honor Society, Key Club, Habitat for Humanity, a faith-based organization, or other service-oriented organization.
- Success involving programming, app development, or other computer science-related endeavors like Girls Who Code; or remarkable success at events like hackathons, competitive programming competitions or techfests.
- Demonstrated excellence with robotics outside of FIRST, VEX or OCCRA (those organizations have their own Kettering scholarships available). Viable examples might include B.E.S.T. Robotics or Zero Robotics.
- Extraordinary involvement in Shell Eco-marathon, Autocross, Innovative Vehicle Design, or similarly-themed activities.
- High achievement in Science Olympiad or Academic Decathlon, or through involvement in math, science, or engineering clubs or competitions like those sponsored by NASA.
- Any endeavor that demonstrates remarkable entrepreneurship, an innovative approach, and dedication to a unique idea.
