Information and Instructions:

The Upper class Scholarships are made possible by donations made to Kettering University by alumni and friends of the University. These scholarships are offered to students who are expected to have obtained sophomore status or higher by July 1, 2018.

Some of the scholarships require other documentation such as an essay or letter of recommendation. **Please read carefully for other documentation that may be required.**

When criteria includes financial need, students must submit the 2018-2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

If you are awarded a scholarship, you will be required to submit a thank you letter addressed to the donor before the scholarship will be credited to your account. Scholarship donors are generous and caring people who unselfishly give to support the educational endeavors of students like you. Your letter reminds them why they gave in the first place and often help secure continuing gifts for future students.

Scholarships are awarded competitively based on criteria listed below as well as many other factors such as academic honors and awards, community service and extracurricular activities.
